Rules for Entries:

All adult exhibitors must pay a \$5 membership fee to the Stirling Fair.

There is no charge for Junior or Youth exhibitors unless exhibiting in an adult class.

All entries are accepted in the Arena between (a) 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Thursday evening and (b) 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Friday morning. Doors close promptly at 10:00 a.m.

Judging begins at 10:30 a.m. Friday morning.

Only one entry per section of each class permitted.

All entries must be the exhibitor's own work.

All entries must be of prize-worthy condition appearing NEW, CLEAN and UNWORN.

Any exhibit, even though it may be the only entry in its class, will be awarded a prize only if it possesses sufficient merit.

Make sure all collections are uniform. Attach or package collections of craft and sewing securely together.

Entries must NOT have been shown in the Stirling Fair previously to this year.

Print entry tag numbers carefully. See sample tag for details

The judges are experienced in their fields of interest and are not members of this fair board.

Entries may not be removed until after 5:00 P.M. Sunday afternoon,.

Note: Men may enter any adult category in this prize book!

(See specific Rules & Regulations). If you wish your quilt to be entered in the competition, state yes on your entry tag.
- D. All Quilts must be hand quilted unless otherwise specified.
- E. Quilt pattern or title must be written on entry tag.

3. Snapshots are to be no larger than 5" x 7" mounted on black bristol board 8"x 10". Entries mounted on less than 8" x 10" will not be judged. No other coloured mount allowed. All exhibitor's tags must be attached securely in the upper right-hand corner of the photograph mount. Take care that the tag does not cover the photograph.
4. Place the name of the section for the photograph on the bristol board, e.g. Children having fun.
5. Enlargements are to be no larger than 8" x 12" mounted on black bristol board with a boarder no larger than 2". Entry tags and labels are to mount the same as for snapshots.
6. Previously submitted entries are not eligible: (a) in the same section (b) in a different section.
